DETAILS:

DIRECTIONS TO CHRISTOPHER FARM & GARDENS, W580 Garton Road, Sheboygan, WI 53083 (From City of Sheboygan):

1. Take I-43 North to the last Sheboygan exit 128, Route 42 (Sheboygan/Howards Grove Exit).
3. Take a right turn onto Route 42 and immediately get into the left hand lane and turn left onto 40th Street, also known as Dairyland Road (just after the Hardees Restaurant).
4. Turn left onto 40th Street. Proceed North for two miles to Garton Road.
5. Turn right (east) onto Garton Road and proceed for about two miles until you come to the Orchard Parking field that will be on your right. There will be a sign with an arrow directing you down the driveway – parking is on the grass.

TOURING OPTIONS:

We will offer several touring options:

- Steps to Survivorship: This group will leisurely tour the Christopher Farm & Gardens. A representative from the property will accompany this group to provide details and answer questions about the property as well.
- Information will be available for anyone interested in learning more about labyrinths and experience the on-site labyrinth.
- Or, you may choose to tour the Christopher Farm & Gardens on your own!

TIMES:

- 4:00PM – Meet at the “Front Gate Entrance” of the Orchard Parking field. You will be greeted here and provided a map of the property and further information.
- 5:30PM – For anyone arriving later and wanting to join a group: Meet at the front gate entrance of the Orchard Parking field or locate the Conservatory. Shortly after 5:30P we will be announcing the winners of the “Survivorship Through the Lens” People’s Choice Photo Contest and “Jay’s Top Pix!”
- 6:00PM – Gentle Yoga for Cancer Survivors – Location to be determined. Meet at the Conservatory immediately following the announcements. Be sure to bring a mat!
- 7:00PM – Depart from Christopher Farm & Gardens
